Prep Uniform

Wearing a school uniform is a badge of pride, it creates our identity and is an important part of being a member of our school community. Wearing it says 'we're all in this together.'

I am striving to see a more consistent and formal approach to our uniform standards and wish for every child to wear the correct uniform with great pride each day.

Pupils not wearing the correct school uniform or PE kit in the short-term should have a letter from their parent explaining the situation and an expected date when it will all be present.

If no letter is present, the following sanctions will be in place:

- 1st occasion - warning in their diary
- 2nd occasion - teacher will make contact with the parent and address this directly
- 3rd occasion - parents will be contacted and the pupil will not be able to join lessons until the uniform is present.

Prep Pupils: (Reception – Year 6)

Boys

- Grey trousers, white shirt, blue Auckland College jumper, blue and grey tie, black socks, flat black leather shoes (Velcro fastening) and Blue Auckland College blazer.

Girls

- Auckland College pinafore, white shirt, blue Auckland College cardigan, blue and grey tie, black/white socks/tights, flat black leather shoes (Velcro fastening) blue Auckland College Blazer and black Auckland College hat.

Coat – Blue Auckland College fleece lined coat or plain black waterproof coat

PE Kit:

- White Auckland College polo shirt
- Black Auckland College sweatshirt
- Plain black jogging bottoms or shorts (not leggings)
- Black/white socks
- Black/white trainers/pumps
